### RRBC Commission and Committee Meetings

- All RRBC and RRBC committee meetings are publicly noticed through the clerks of the elected bodies of each member jurisdiction, SWCDs, and the TJPDC as well as locality calendars, the *Daily Progress*, on the RRBC and *Charlottesville Tomorrow* websites.
- RRBC meeting information and materials are emailed to Commissioners on Tuesday of the week before the meeting *and* posted online at the RRBC webpage for that meeting (TAC members are copied on these emails).
- TAC meeting information are emailed to TAC members no later than Friday of the week before the upcoming Tuesday meeting and posted online (commissioners are copied on these emails).
- Commissioners are requested to send an email confirmation to RRBC regarding attendance at RRBC meetings to ensure a quorum (8 of 14 members must be present to conduct RRBC business).
- Commissioners are welcome to attend TAC meetings and visa versa.
