

#### What is a Conservation District?


Formed in 1930s in response to Dust Bowl to create local influence







#### **Cumulative Agricultural Impact since 1998**





**Cost Share Paid to Landowners in 2020** 


#### Agriculture in Albemarle County

There are 913 farms in Albemarle County and 94% are family farms.



#### Demographics of Producers








59% of farm operations are greater than 50 acres. The average farm size is 200 acres.

Cattle has the greatest number of operations in Albemarle County based on sales and inventory.





